Allied Cooperative exists for their members and takes their relationships with their member-owners very seriously. Allied has a number of additional businesses, both retail and agricultural in the Adams, Portage, and Wood County areas which include: Cenex Pump 24 in Adams, NAPA Auto Parts in Adams and Mauston; Mauston Tire Shop; LP and fuel services; grain facilities in Adams, Mauston and Wisconsin Rapids; agronomy facilities in Adams, Mauston and Plover and Pest Pros crop consulting services in Plainfield. The company also has operations in Arcadia, Blair, Galesville, Mindoro, Tomah and West Salem.
